## SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISHES OF BRIGHTWELL, FOXHALL, MARTLESHAM AND WALDRINGFIELD) (A12 AND SURROUNDING ROADS) (40 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2022

On 23 February 2022, Suffolk County Council made the above order under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of this is to:

- reduce the speed limit to 50 mph in both directions on part of the A12, and on parts of Anson Road, Barrack Square and Eagle Way from the roundabouts with the A12; and,
- reduce the speed limit to 40 mph on parts of Waldringfield Road and Ipswich Road.
